Zwedru Grand Gedeh County Monday Feb. 12, 2018...Today Monday February 12, 2018 dozens of youths of the former ruling Unity Party (UP) and the current ruling Party, the Coalition for Democratic Change (CDC) in the CDC stronghold of GRAND GEDEH County are expected to dialogue on managing the expectations of the GEORGE WEAH led CDC government and the sustenance and maintenance of post elections peace after the December 26, 2017 run-off presidential election.

A host of youth leaders from the two main political parties will appear as guest panelists to dialogue with perspectives on the apparent impatience of the GRAND GEDEH people who feel that their strong and overwhelming support for GEORGE WEAH and the CDC is not reaping their expected benefits of jobs in the government early enough.

The CDC and Unity Party youths and their leaders will appear on "THE DIALOGUE", the media and community outreach blend of People To People flagship platform at the Grand Gedeh Town of TUZON, the home of the late Liberian president SAMUEL KANYON DOE, near the city of ZWEDRU.

The TUZON forum is being necessitated by the apparent wild spread verbal discontent about what the people here say is the failure yet of president GEORGE WEAH to appoint GRAND GEDEH citizens to senior positions in the new administration.

\There are two schools of thought here in GRAND GEDEH County; One that GEORGE WEAH is not taking due cognizance of the massive support given him in the election by GRAND GEDEH County, hence his failure or delay in appointing the county's people to senior positions and Two that it's just quite early to expect so much from the President and new administration, though they got massive support from the people of GRAND GEDEH County.

The forum at TUZON today will see a debate style conversational dialogue between a select set of guest panelists on one hand and the people of TUZON town on the other.

Today's youth sensitive DIALOGUE forum will be the latest in the last set of intensive and sustained elections peace forums targeting the South Eastern Region aimed at preventing youth oriented elections violence supported by the UNITED NATIONS DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM (UNDP).

As ever the deliberations from tomorrow's forum will be broadcast live on community radios at ZWEDRU and subsequent rebroadcast on our partner network 45 National and Rural Community Radios around Liberia.
